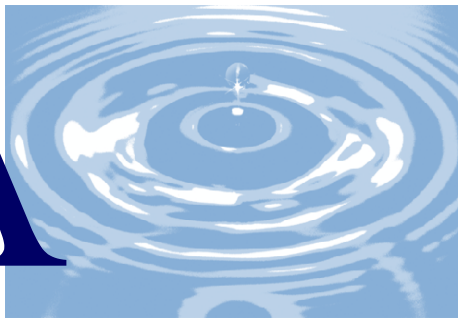

Phase II Program Overview

The six minimum measures to promote pollutant load reduction.

Public Education & Outreach

How to distribute educational materials and perform outreach to inform citizens of reasons to control storm water runoff..

Public Participation/Involvement

How to provide opportunities for citizens to participate in storm water program development and implementation.

Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination

How to develop and implement a plan to detect and eliminate illicit discharges in the storm water system.

Morning Break/Vendor Visits

Construction Site Runoff Control

How to develop, implement and enforce a sediment and erosion control program for construction activities.

Post Construction Runoff Control

How to develop, implement and enforce a program to address discharges of post-construction runoff and appropriate storm water treatment practices (STP's).

How to develop and implement a program with the goal of preventing or reducing pollutant runoff from municipal operations.
